

- OR You can grab a taxi and head to a more intimate Comptoir 102 Healthy Cafe and Concept Store or <u>Kulture</u> <u>House</u>, two of my favorite charming cafes. They are a great place to unwind before your next thrill.



Afternoon (2:30 PM-5:30 PM)

- To enjoy panoramic views of Downtown Dubai without the Burj Khalifa ticket expense, consider visiting the <u>Address Sky</u> <u>View</u>. It offers an observatory experience with great views of Downtown Dubai (floors 52 and 53), including the iconic Burj Khalifa and a complimentary glass slide!
- Ready for an additional adrenaline rush? The Sky Views
 Observatory Edge Walk is a thrilling experience in Dubai, offering a hands-free walk along the top of the Tower's main pod, over 219.5 meters above the ground, providing unobstructed cityscape views.



Late afternoon (5:30 PM - 8:30 PM)

- Walk directly from Address Sky View into The Dubai Mall, one
 of the world's largest shopping destinations.
- While inside The Dubai Mall, don't forget to have a look at the Dubai Aquarium. Marvel at the stunning marine life, including over 400 sharks and rays, residing in the impressive 10 millionlitre tank. You can also experience the thrill of walking with the sharks without the need for a scuba diving certificate
- Head to the outdoor Dubai Fountain area, located just outside
 The Dubai Mall. Witness the captivating water and light shows
 set to music, creating a mesmerizing spectacle against the
 backdrop of the Burj Khalifa.



Evening (8:30 PM - late)
